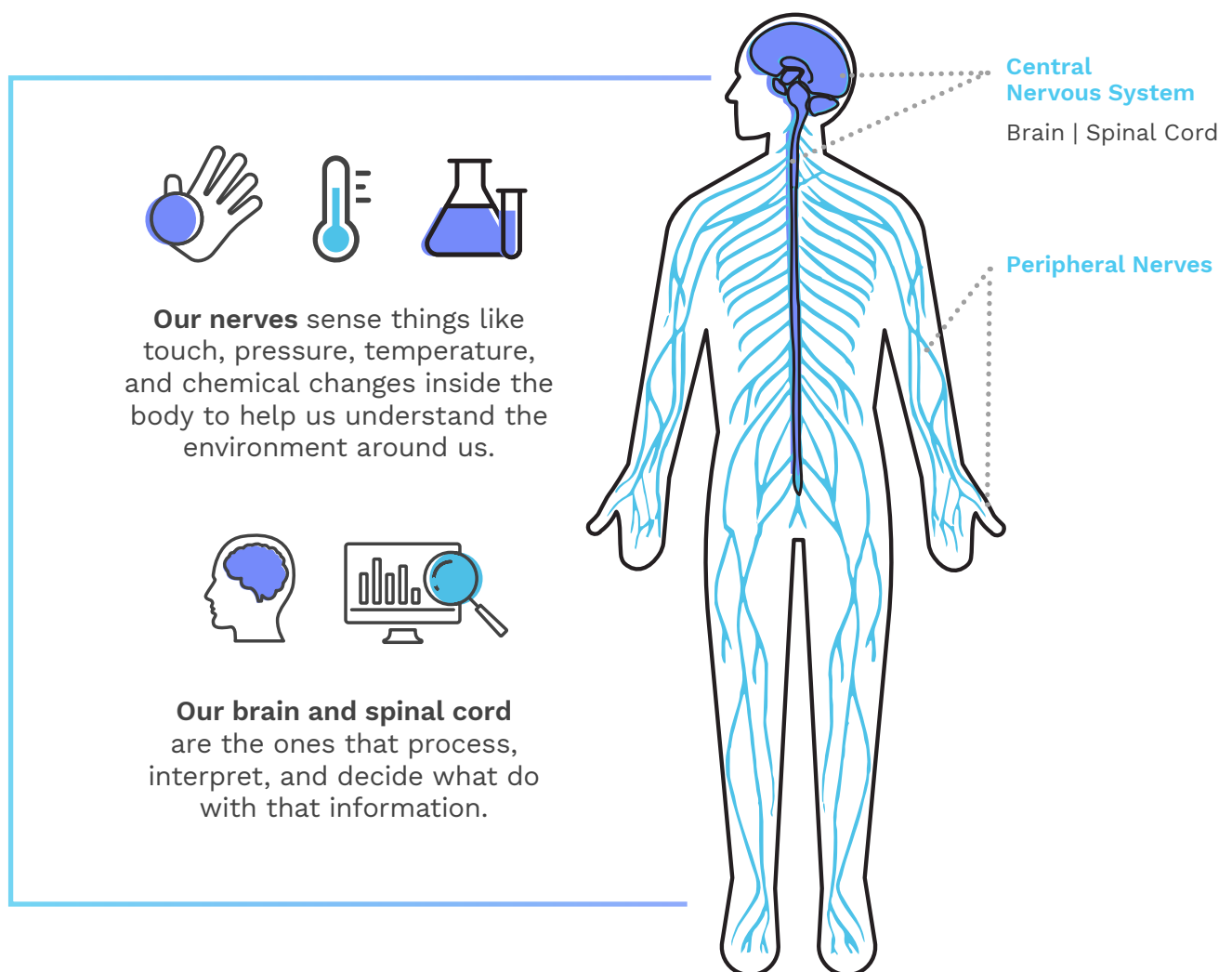


THE CENTRAL NERVOUS SYSTEM (CNS):

The brain and spinal cord are the main processing centers of the nervous system.

THE PERIPHERAL NERVOUS SYSTEM (PNS):

These branches of nerves exit the spinal cord and travel throughout the body. They act like two- way highways that relay information to and from the CNS.
