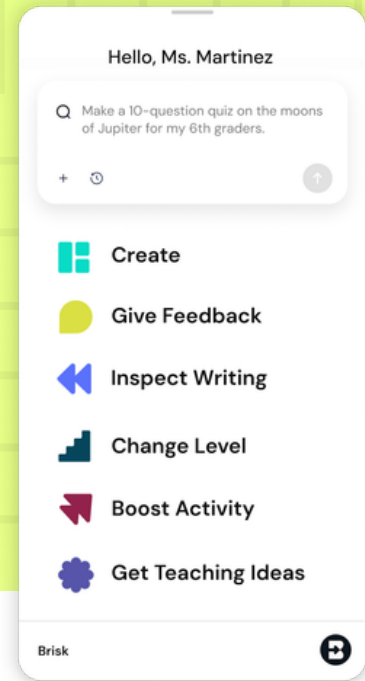

Create, give feedback, and adapt instruction inside the tools you already use.

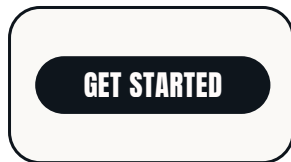

Go to briskteaching.com and click “Get Started”

Works on Google Chrome or Microsoft Edge. Add the Brisk extension to your browser in one click.

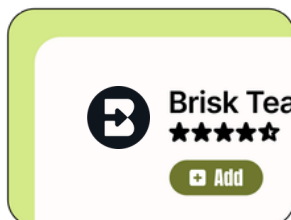

Create your Brisk account

Sign up with your **Google, Microsoft, or Email credentials**. You'll see a pop-up asking for permissions. This is standard for any extension, Brisk is safe and secure.

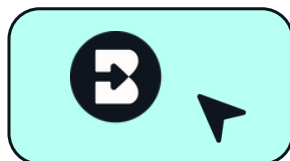

Pin Brisk to your toolbar

Once you pin Brisk, it will pop up across your browser to save you time.

Open any tab. Click the B.

CREATE

Build what you need, wherever you are.



Click the Brisk 'B' to open Brisk over a resource of your choice.

Optional: Use the + in the prompt box to upload PDFs or images



Two ways to create – try both



Type what you want in the chat box, e.g. "Create a quiz"



Click Create and pick from the library, e.g. Quiz



Answer a few optional questions to refine your resource, then click **Create**
