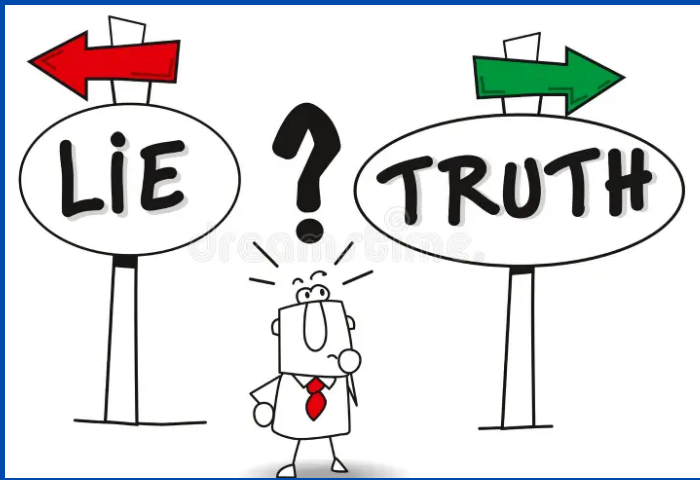


FUN WAYS TO GET TO KNOW EACH OTHER.

TWO TRUTHS AND A LIE.

Each student writes 2 true facts and 1 untrue fact about themselves. In small groups or pairs they read them out loud. The others have to guess the lie.

Encourage them to be creative but also school appropriate!

GETTING TO KNOW YOU BINGO

Give each student a 'Find someone who' bingo card. Students then mingle to find a classmate who can match the box and writes their name in the square. Aim to complete a row and then a full card.

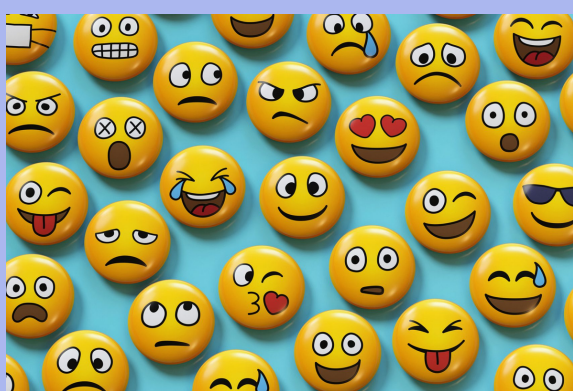

BACKPACK ME

Give each student a blank backpack. Ask them to 'pack' it with 5 things that represents them - these can be written words, drawings or symbols. Share in pairs or small groups. This could then make up a class display titled '*What we carry with us*'

EMOJI ME

Give students a blank sheet with emoji faces on. Ask them to write a short story of themselves using these emojis to describe moments in their life. They can then lay these out on tables and people can walk around and read them in a silent exhibition.

SECRET SUPERPOWERS MATCH UP

Ask each student to write down a superpower they have - real ones not fantasy ones, on strips of paper. Examples: *I can name every premier league team* or *I bake amazing brownies*. Mix up the strips of paper and read them aloud. The class has to guess who they belong to Students can claim if they want.

MAP MY LIFE CHALLENGE

Get students draw a mini 'Life Map' on paper. Key features should include: a home icon, a landmark - a proud memory, a path - goal or dream, a bridge - someone who helped them through something, a mountain - something they overcame, treasure - something they have achieved.
