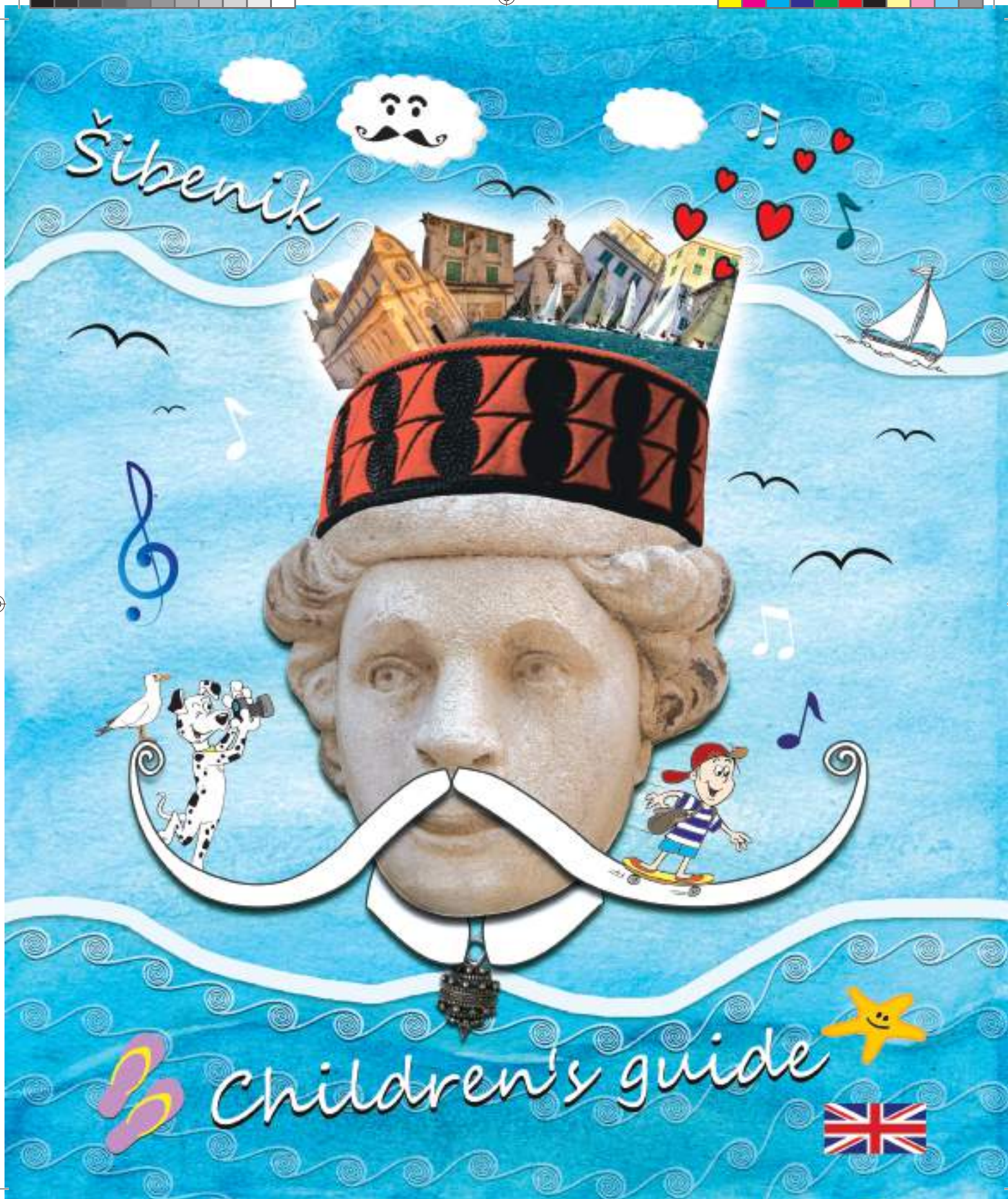

CITY MONUMENTS



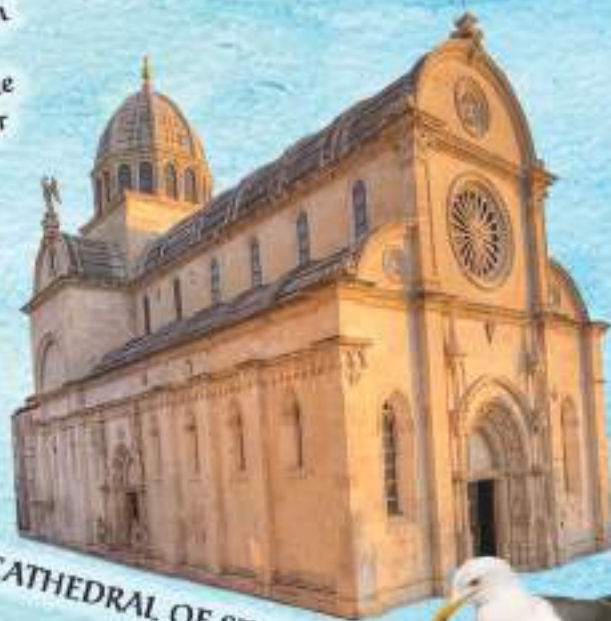
Šibenik is called the city of King Krešimir. It is also called the city of fortress and there are 4 of them in Šibenik. The city is located in the bay at the mouth of the wonderful Krka river which comes into the sea through the channel of St. Anthony. The city was built long time ago on a foothill near the fortress of St. Michael which has a view of the sea. If you take a walk through the town, from Poljana to the park, you will see the statue of a Croatian King Petar Krešimir IV. He watches over the city and maybe he will whisper to you that Šibenik was first mentioned in a written document back in the year 1066. Citizens of Šibenik are very proud of the glorious past of their town.



FORTRESS OF ST. MICHAEL
is the oldest part of the city with the remains from the late Bronze Age.

ŠIBENIK CITY MUSEUM



If you walk along the coast, you will see the old cannons. Behind them is the Duke's palace where the city duke once resided. There is a big surprise there: Šibenik museum! Imagine, it stores a collection of 150,000 objects: old coins, pots, paintings, sculptures, maps, arrows, swords, the glass snail and bunny! It has on display the oldest dice for board games too. The Museum preserves the heritage of Šibenik and the Šibenik region. Take care of your heritage, too!

AMOR D CANI

Once upon a time citizens of Šibenik carved the stone water basin for thirsty dogs and cats. The inscription on it says: TO DOGS WITH LOVE. Citizens of Šibenik are very fond of children and animals, too! Meow, meow...wow, wow! Bravo for Šibenik!

That Šibenik is the city with the largest number of church organs and stairs in Croatia.



FORTRESS ŠUBIĆEVAC -BARONE



It was built at the same time as the fortress of St. John and served for defence. This fortress was named by Croatian noble family Šubić.

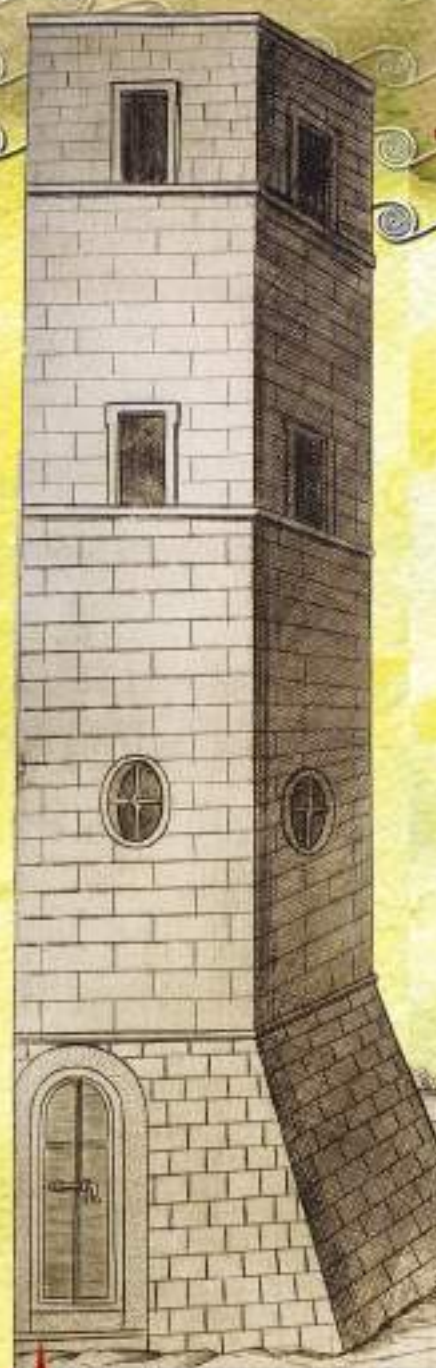
ŽIŽULA (Chinese date)

If you visit Šibenik in September you will see in the streets and squares: majorettes, jugglers, dancers, singers and hear a gun salute from old cannons. Knights' contests, ancient crafts, sweets and toys, can also be seen. The medieval toys were rattles, bells, drums and wooden figures. Instruments were trumpets, bells and drums. At that time, women were wearing veils and long dresses.

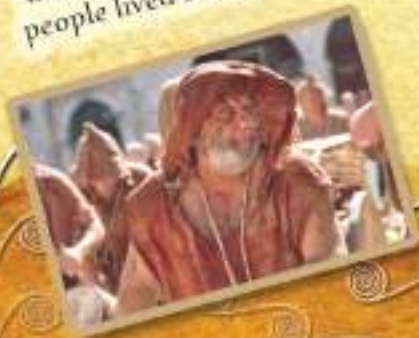
FRITULE (flour fritters) – Šibenik's Christmas cake

You can help adults in preparation: 4 tea
spoons of oil, 5 dag of sugar, 3 egg yolks
50 dag of flour, 2 del of milk, 2 dag of
yeast, grated lemon zest, a bit of salt and
raisins. Mix all ingredients and let the
dough swell a while. After the dough has
risen, use a small spoon to place pieces of
dough into 1/2 litre of medium hot oil.
When done to light brown colour, sprinkle
them with sugar. Yummy!

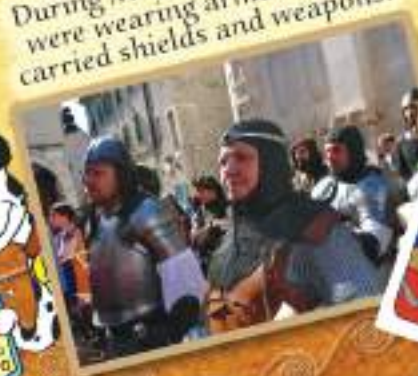


CATAPULT

FALCONRY is a medieval hunting discipline practised by noblemen. They had patient and skilful hawkers who trained the birds of prey such as falcons, hawks and eagles for hunting.

FALCONRY CENTER

In the falconry centre you will be able to learn a lot about falconry and different types of birds of prey. There is also a hospital, the only one in Croatia for wounded, sick or starved birds. They can get needed assistance there.

ISLANDS – KORNATI NATIONAL PARK

In the sea of Šibenik, there are 242 islands and the Kornati islands are one of the most beautiful in Croatia. They are not forested, but they have many long stone walls. In former times shepherds from Murter used to keep their sheep within those walls. To get to Kornati, they used to sail with wooden boat – gajeta.



The town of Zablac̃e was once known for sea salt production. On the Island of Krapanj, people used to hunt sea-sponges and process them.

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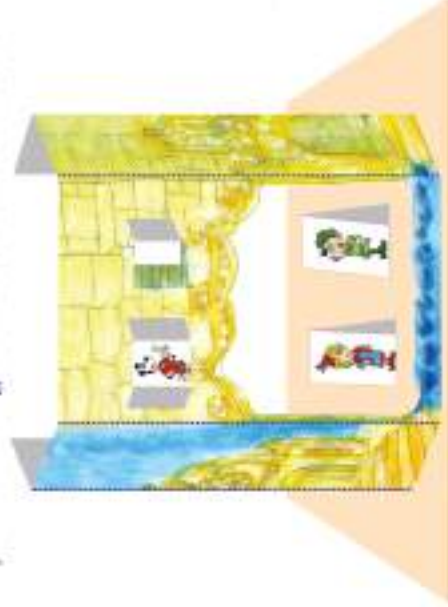
