Acts Leadership College (ALC) is a vibrant theology and leadership college with the heart to raise up leaders of all ages through biblically sound, character-based training.

ALC was birthed in 2020 from Ps Steve Mazey's simple desire to train and equip leaders within the local church. What started out as a small class room of first year students has now become a flourishing college producing many anointed and gifted graduates, spread out over three campuses and three qualifications.

We partner with **Planetshakers College**, accredited by Australian University College of Divinity, to produce world class content, in an environment of encounter and discipleship.

We offer three levels of government certified qualifications that we believe will lay a biblically sound foundation for any student that is interested in leadership, ministry, theology, or simply growing stronger in their faith.

In the following booklet you'll receive further information on our Diploma, Associate Degree and Bachelor of Arts degree that we offer here at ALC and hope to pave the way for your church to partner with us.

ALC is currently in its 6th year of running and has seen 40+ students complete their Diploma, 15+ students complete their Associate Degree, and 4 students complete their Bachelor's Degree, alongside 30+ current students well on their way to completing their college experience and qualifications.

We offer an internship program that is written into college curriculum to cater for the practical side of ministry and hope the structure that we have designed will be a blessing to your church.

In essence, we are a national Bible college that partners with local churches to see people of all ages equipped with in-depth theology and leadership teaching.

COLLEGE LIFE

A typical day in the life of ALC looks like:
1 day of Lectures & Chapel at your College Campus
1 day of Stream (internship) & tutorials at your college campus or local church
+ Serving 3 out of 4 Sundays (within a month) at your local church & multiple Acts Global Churches events throughout the year.

DIPLOMA OF LEADERSHIP

Through the introduction of foundational principles for personal and professional leadership, ministry and theology, you will be equipped to lead in your area of influence, whilst being grounded in a robust Biblical and Theological foundation. You will be given the opportunity to practice Christian leadership principles in your chosen ministry stream and in a cross-cultural mission trip, solidifying theoretical principles with practical experience.

Course Duration

1 year (Full Time student)

Future Pathways

The completed Diploma of Leadership can be used as credit equivalent to the first year of a Bachelor of Theology or Bachelor of Ministry.

Entry Requirements

Aged 21+ OR completion of Year 10

SURVEY OF THE OLD & NEW

→ TESTAMENT (B511OP & B515OP)

Go deeper in God's word with a thorough survey of the Bible. Taken in two units over the whole year, students will read through the entire Bible either individually or in groups. The lectures and assessments will focus on the books, authors, general themes, concepts, historical concepts and unifying theology of the Old and New Testaments. Students will be equipped with basic exegetical strategies to understand Scripture and will be challenged to apply the truths of Scripture to their personal lives and contemporary situations.

TRANSFORMATIONAL

→ LEADERSHIP (P516IP)

Transformational Leadership teaches students how to apply basic leadership principles in a variety of Ministry and workplace environments. Covering topics like Natural vs Spiritual Leadership, the Art of Delegating and the Sacrifices of Leadership, students will learn practical skills as well as the theory behind leadership principles. The unit culminates in a panel with a variety of established leaders to ensure students are learning what is used in workplaces today.

PERSON & WORK OF THE HOLY

→ SPIRIT (T5116P)

This unit is a central part of the Diploma of Leadership at ALC and deals with our Pentecostal distinctives and philosophy of ministry. Students will study and prepare assessments about the Holy Spirit, but more than that, students will be trained to operate in the miraculous gifts of the Spirit. Each lecture and tutorial has both a scriptural and a practical component which will encourage students to grow in their understanding of the move of the Spirit in an environment of encounter.

INTRODUCTION TO CHRISTIAN

→ DOCTRINE (T5105P)

Introduction to Christian Doctrines is the foundational unit of ALC. It teaches a strong understanding for students to grow in their faith. Come discover what the Bible has to say about God, Creation, and the Fall, the nature of humanity, angels and demons, the atonement and resurrection of Christ and much more.

→ INTRODUCTION TO LEADERSHIP (P5155P)

Introduction to Christian Leadership is a unit focused on self-leadership and personal discipleship. Students are taught spiritual disciplines, character integrity and basic self and small group leadership principles to equip them to serve the Church in a greater capacity. This unit also covers the traits and behaviours of Biblically sound leadership, how to identify leaders in the real world and in turn, how to develop oneself as a leader.

→ BASICS OF PASTORAL PREACHING (P5150P)

Basics of Pastoral Preaching is a unit which equips students with the tools to develop their communication skills. Not only do students learn about the art of preaching, but they are given the tools to differentiate between skill and operating under the anointing. Students learn to tailor sermons in response to a variety of contexts and operate with the Holy Spirit in delivering the Gospel message. Basics of Pastoral Preaching is assessed by delivering a testimony, a sermon and a speech.

→ SUPERVISED MINISTRY 1 (P517IP)

An internship unit that allows students to learn the practice of ministry in the local church setting. This unit will build important skills regardless of which vocation students plan to pursue. This subject requires oversight from the referring church in order to provide a mentor for the student.

ASSOCIATE DEGREE OF THEOLOGY AND MINISTRY

Building on the foundations of the Diploma of Leadership, you will dive deeper into Christian Theology and Biblical Studies. You will be equipped with guiding principles for Christian Ministry in contemporary society, develop spiritual disciplines in your own personal discipleship and consider Christian Ethical principles within the context of non-Christian worldviews.

2 years (Full Time students)

Future Pathways

The completed Associate Degree can be used as credit equivalent to the second year of a Bachelor of Arts

Entry Requirements

Successful completion of Diploma of Leadership or equivalent.

→ CHURCH HISTORY (H6100P)

Early Church History traces Christian history from Christ to the birth of the Pentecostal movement. While students are being introduced to the rich history and tradition of the Christian Church, they will focus on the heroes and villains of the faith. This subject is also intended to impart a deeper knowledge of Pentecostal heritage as well. Students will learn about key figures in the Christian Church, doctrinal disputes, the creeds, the reformation and various renewal movements within modern Church history.

→ ROMANS (B6261P)

Arguably the apex of Pauline thought, not to mention the New Testament theology, the letter to the Romans offers the clearest and fullest teaching of the gospel of Jesus Christ. This is an exegetical unit that will give students deeper insights into the historical situation of 1st century Christianity, the problems facing the emerging gentile church and the enduring truth of the Christian message.

→ THE PENTATEUCH (B6212P)

In Pentateuch, students will take a deep dive into the first 5 books of the Bible. This unit looks at the culture and customs of the day, while also exploring heroes of the faith, like Abraham and Moses. This unit will equip students in their exegesis of the Bible by providing a strong understanding of the Law and of God's heart for His people.

CHRISTIAN ETHICS (E6100P)

- Is a subject which teaches students how to think about making ethical decisions through various ethical frameworks. Students will be exposed to several ethical frameworks and their strengths and weaknesses, learn to think critically through them and assess their usefulness in a given scenario.

→ SUPERVISED MINISTRY 2 (P6172P)

This unit places our students in the activity of their local church. It enables them to volunteer one day a week as part of their internship and develop the skills needed to best serve their church. This subject formalizes the internship aspect of their Associate Degree and keeps their work practical. Serving for this subject may include; Pastoral Care, Creative Ministry, Youth Ministry, Kids Ministry, Church Conferences or anything that your church has a need for.

→ BIBLICAL HERMENEUTICS (B7203P)

In this unit, we examine a variety of hermeneutical methods, with specific focus on the hermeneutical principles involved with interpretation and application in 21st century ministry contexts. Some of the topics we look at include; Online Word Study Tools, Good vs Bad Interpretation, Memorising Scripture, Use of the Old Testament in the New, Holy Spirit and the Word of God and many more.

→ INTRODUCTION TO PERSONAL TRANSFORMATION (S6103P)

Personal Transformation explores the intersection of theology and psychology as we journey through topics such as suffering and the effects of trauma on humanity. This unit will look to Scripture as a basis for God's pathway for healing and wholeness in us as tripartite sons and daughters. In the context of this discussion, this unit will focus on emotionally healthy spirituality, the renewed mind, and stewarding the body for fruitful labour without burnout.

→ THE PERSON AND WORK OF CHRIST (T6210P)

Explores the realm of Christology and Soteriology. Students will develop an in-depth understanding of the Trinity: the person and nature of Christ and the work of the cross. This class expands on the orthodox theology presented in Introduction to Christian Doctrines in the Diploma of Leadership and takes students to a deeper level.

BACHELOR OF ARTS

BACHELOR OF ARTS (BIBLE & THEOLOGY)

The Bachelor of Arts (Bible & Theology) consolidates your Biblical and theological studies with units in Christian Apologetics, New Testament Greek and the exegesis of several New Testament books. The course prepares you for vocational ministry in a role that requires preaching and teaching. Students in the Bachelor of Theology program are invited to participate in many Acts Global Churches conferences and gatherings around Australia.

BACHELOR OF ARTS (PASTORAL CARE & CHAPLAINCY)

The Bachelor of Arts (Pastoral Care & Chaplaincy) offers units in Personal Transformation, Pastoral & Spiritual Care, Mental Health Response, and an Introduction to Pastoral Ministry & Theology. You will receive training in advanced pastoral ministry practices, preparing you for leading ministry roles in and out of the context of the local Church. Those who have completed this degree will also be professionally qualified to work in Chaplaincy positions. Students in the Bachelor of Ministry program are invited to participate in many Acts Global Churches conferences and gatherings around Australia.

AGC NATIONAL CONFERENCE

Acts Global Churches National Conference is a three-day annual conference held in Melbourne (VIC) open to all pastors and leaders within the AGC movement. ALC Students play a vital role in serving across the entire conference, including the AGC's Young Leaders Conference.



YOUNG LEADERS CONFERENCE

Acts Global Churches National Young Leaders Conference is held two days prior to our National Conference and provides an opportunity for all ALC students to serve and gain practical ministry experience across multiple areas.

HISTORY MAKERS CONFERENCE (VIC)

History Makers Conference is a Youth Conference held and hosted by Victory Church Bendigo. HMC is overseen by Conference Directors Ps. Rhys and Steph Hardy, whose hearts are set on seeing young people encounter the power and presence of Jesus.



HOPE TOUR

Hope Tour is a national schools tour dedicated to bringing a powerful message of hope to young people across multiple schools in Australia. Hope Tour is overseen and led by Adam Woods, whose mission is to inspire, uplift and encourage young people with a message of hope.

ALC INTENSIVE CAMP

Each year, ALC hosts a camp for all students at all levels of study. Hosted at different locations, this event offers an incredible opportunity for personal growth, investment, and time for connection with our wider college community from around Australia!



DREAMBUILDERS CONFERENCE (WA)

This multi-generational conference happens annually for our Western Australia students. It gathers people and brings the opportunity to encounter God, be immersed in His Presence, receive greater revelation of the Word and fellowship with one another. This conference is designed to empower and encourage you in your personal relationship with Jesus.



MISSION TRIP

Students will have the opportunity to participate in a mission trip with their local church or join a mission trip with another AGC church during their college experience. We believe this is where all the theological and leadership knowledge gained in the classroom comes together and is practically outworked on the mission field.

WHY CHOOSE ACTS LEADERSHIP COLLEGE?

Why ALC? It's simple. We are one of the only Bible Colleges in Australia that not only offers 3 government certified qualifications in Theology and Ministry, but a combined, structured internship program that allows you to grow practically as a leader within a local church.

What does this mean? It means that you no longer have to travel interstate to receive a bible college experience.

You can study AND intern within your local church, or an established ALC location near you, whilst we take care of the rest!



We offer clear pathways to study and intern with us and aim to work one-on-one with each individual student to see the best possible outcome. This means one of three things:

1. You, as a student, are welcome to travel to an established ALC location to study and intern, then return to serve at your local church after completing your college experience.
2. You can travel to an established ALC location to study and return to your church to intern and serve throughout the week.
3. You can study AND intern within your local church, both on your church site or as an online student, no travel needed. So what does this look like practically? It looks like having one day a week allocated to lectures and tutorials, and another day allocated to interning in your church, called a Streams Day. Our Internship program includes 1:1 mentoring sessions, serving in a team on Sundays, and participating in all Acts Global Churches events.

01. What does it cost?

Diploma, \$12,000 (*\$1,500 Per Subject*)

Associate Degree, \$14,200 (*\$1,775 Per Subject*)

Bachelor, \$17,400 (*\$2,175 Per Subject*)

02. How do I enrol?

Please reach out to our ALC staff at alc@victorycc.com.au to discuss enrolment and location. Our staff will walk you through all enrolment steps, as well as clarify any questions you may have around locations, accommodation, timetables and subjects.

03. What if my church isn't an allocated location?

Not to worry, we offer four established locations, Bendigo (VIC), Melbourne (VIC), Bunbury (WA) and Perth (WA) where you can attend, if you wish to travel. Our established locations can assist you in finding accommodation for the duration of your college experience. If travel is not an option, we can set you up as an online student and will discuss practical ministry experience options within your specific context.

04. What support do I receive from ALC?

We offer weekly contact with your college oversight that outlines each subject, lecture, and assignment criteria prior to your college day. We are committed to providing academic support, in-house lectures, online tutorials, and work hard to be contactable for any ongoing support you may need throughout your college experience.

05. Can I pick and choose what day college is on?

Our recommendation is to align your study to our ALC Yearly Calendar. This ensures us the ability to keep all students up to date and on track with their studies. It aligns all online lectures with the present time (including any live lectures from PlanetShakers), helps us coordinate and assign lecturers to you, facilitate multi-location online tutorials, and organise all ALC gatherings such as O-Week, Intensive Week, ALC Camp, Conferences, Events and Mission Trips.
