LOW RISK RESULT

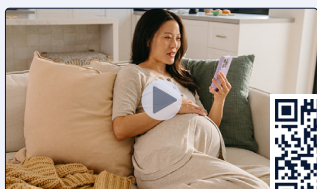
Have clarity on the path ahead with a deeper understanding of your pregnancy's biology.

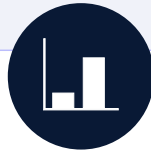
