



Poll Shows Broad Support for Keeping Texas Primary Elections Open to All Voters

🔴 Closing Texas primary elections will negatively impact conservative voters, drive increased costs to state and local governments, and threaten the integrity of our elections.

🗳️ A poll of likely primary voters conducted by Republican pollster **Chris Perkins of Ragnar Research Partners** found strong support—including among likely GOP primary voters—for maintaining current state law that allows any voter to choose whether they want to participate in the Republican or Democratic primary election.

📌 Key findings from the polling found:

- 🗳️ **Voters support current law:** 76% of likely voters support the state's current state law whereby the state's primary elections, funded by state taxpayers, are open to all voters. By party identification, 64% of likely Republican primary voters agree that current law is sufficient.
- ⭐ **Voters value freedom:** 78% of likely voters oppose losing the ability to choose which primary election to vote in. By party identification, 66% percent of likely Republican primary voters oppose losing the ability to choose which primary election to vote in.
- 🔒 **Voters value privacy:** 76% of likely voters oppose requiring registration by party affiliation in order to be allowed to vote in primary elections. By party identification, 58% of likely Republican primary voters oppose requirements to register by party affiliation.

"Texas voters, and especially Republican primary voters, give strong support for the current state law that keeps primary elections open to all voters.
