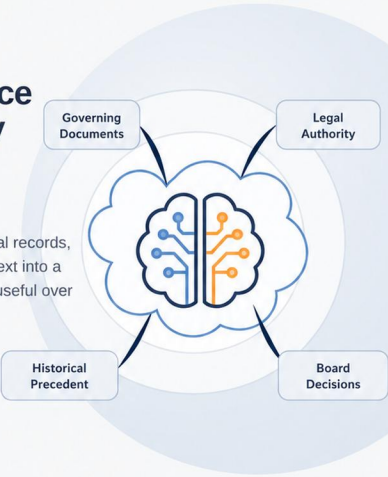


THINKHOA BRAIN INTELLIGENCE

Not a generic chatbot. A structured intelligence layer built around the governance history of one association.

SUBSCRIBER OVERVIEW

An HOA should not have to rediscover its own history.

Most associations already have the information needed to make better governance decisions. The problem is that it is scattered across PDFs, meeting minutes, inboxes, manager memory and old board files.

SIMPLIFIED AUTHORITY HIERARCHY

4. Board-Adopted Governance

5. Historical Interpretation

Prior decisions • Minutes • Enforcement • Maintenance precedent

TWO QUESTIONS MATTER

What controls legally?

ThinkHOA starts with the current governing authority and applicable legal framework.

How has the association applied it?

The system then looks at prior interpretation, board action and historical precedent.

A prior board decision is not automatically “the rule.” It is context that helps the current board understand consistency, precedent and risk.

DOCUMENT STATE

- CURRENT • SUPERSEDED
- DUPLICATE • REQUIRES REVIEW
- EXTERNAL AUTHORITY

History becomes usable governance memory.

Meeting minutes and prior decisions stop being an archive you hope someone remembers. ThinkHOA is designed to connect historical records to the governance questions they can inform later.

EXAMPLE QUESTION

“Can this owner build an accessory structure on this lot?”

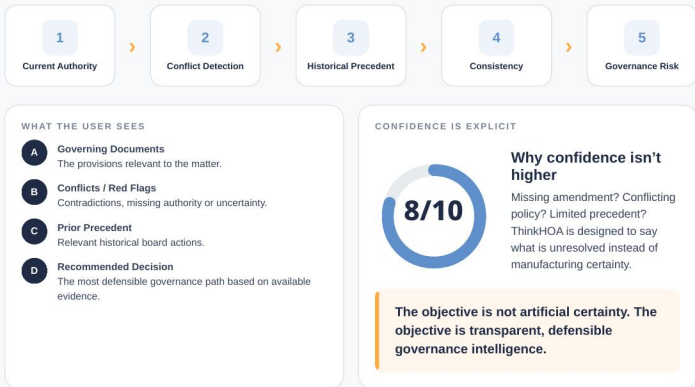
ThinkHOA can connect the question to:

- 1 Current restrictions**
CC&Rs, amendments and architectural standards.
- 2 Relevant law**
Controlled jurisdiction-specific legal authority.
- 3 Similar historical applications**
Prior approvals, denials and imposed conditions.
- 4 Board history**
Meeting minutes and prior interpretation.
- 5 Consistency**
Whether precedent has been applied similarly.

History informs the decision. It does not silently override controlling authority.

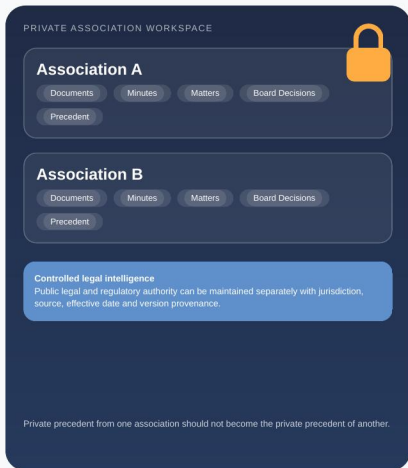
One question. Multiple levels of analysis.

ThinkHOA is designed to evaluate the authority, the history and the governance risk at the same time—then show the user how those layers shaped the recommendation.



Security is more than a login.

For governance AI, protecting context matters as much as protecting access. ThinkHOA is designed so private association records remain inside the association's intelligence boundary.



FOUR SECURITY QUESTIONS

- 1 Who can see it?**
Access is controlled by account, user, association and role.
- 2 Who does it belong to?**
Association-specific records remain in the correct governance context.
- 3 What supports it?**
Conclusions trace back to authority and historical sources.
- 4 Can it be audited?**
Source provenance and preserved history support review.

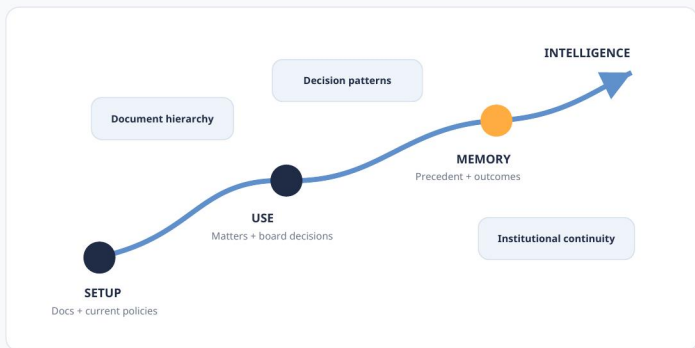
