Energy & Climate

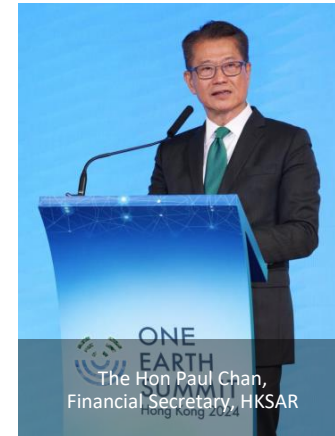
