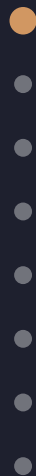


How to deliver great UX?

Only users can judge on those. **Try instead of doubting.** You will gain experience and understand the patterns in which your users act and behave.

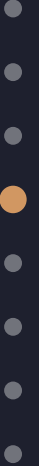
You will make better decisions over time.



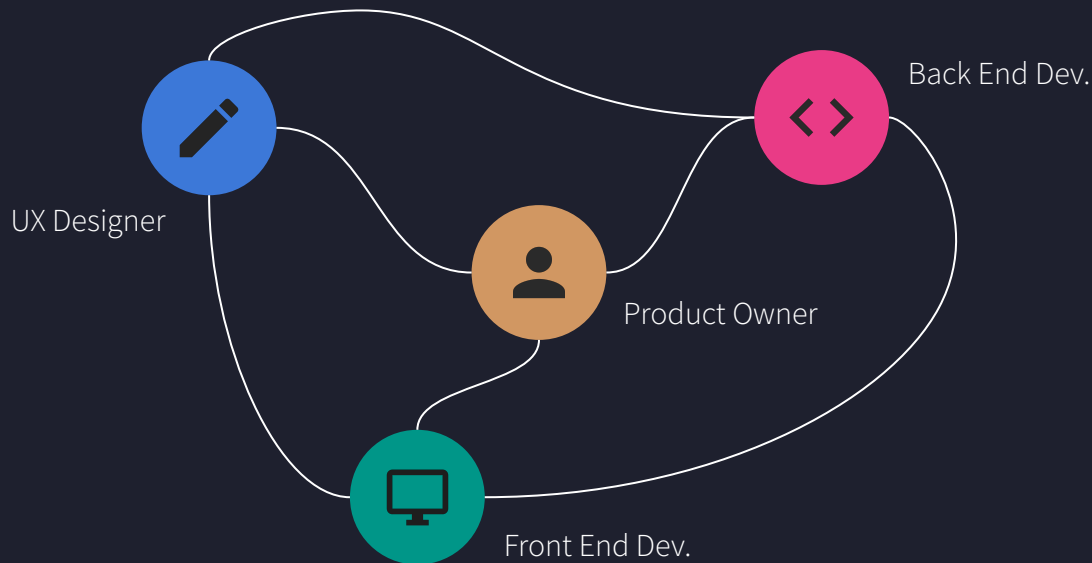
Stay flexible!
